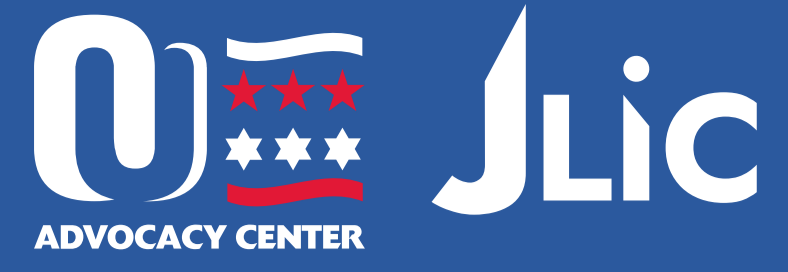


Apply for the OU Leaders In Advocacy Training Program (LIAT)

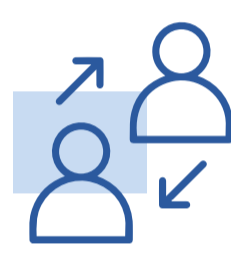
Who Should Apply?

Interactive sessions with political experts and policymakers



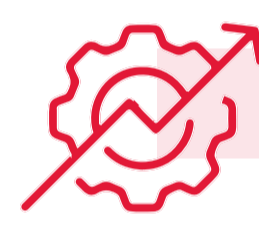
Mentorship from leaders in the Jewish community
